

# NATIONAL PATH TO CERTIFICATION (NCCAOM)

## STEP 2: Send final transcript

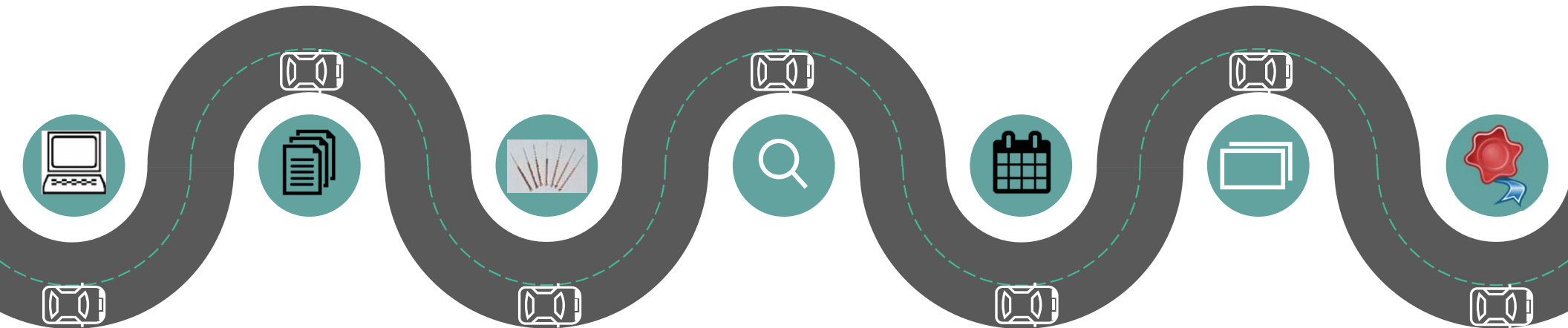
Final (graduated) transcript must be submitted by ACTCM at CIIS prior to approval for testing

## STEP 4: Approval to test

Student will receive email notification, and an authorization to test letter (ATTL) in their NCCAOM online portal

## STEP 6: Complete examinations

Complete exams



## STEP 1: APPLY

Submit online application no more than 60 days prior to graduation, \$595 application fee (Diplomate of Oriental Medicine includes both acupuncture and Chinese Herbology)

## STEP 3: CNT Certification

Complete CCAOM CNT course, and submit CCAOM CNT Certification prior to approval for testing

## STEP 5: Schedule exam/s

Schedule exams through [Pearsonvue.com/NCCAOM](http://Pearsonvue.com/NCCAOM) \$310 per exam. Modules for Diplomate of OM include:

- Acupuncture
- Herbology
- Biomedicine
- Fundamentals

## STEP 7: Receive notification

Certified Diplomate of OM or retest
